

# **NUNTHORPE PARISH COUNCIL EXTRAORDINARY MEETING**

## **DIXONS BANK / STANTON WAY HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT SCHEME**

CHANDLERS RIDGE ACADEMY, SCHOOL HALL, NUNTHORPE, TS7 0JL  
Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> March at 7pm

As many of you may already know, Middlesbrough Council is proposing significant road works to Dixons Bank and Stainton Way. The proposals consist of widening the existing carriageway on Dixons Bank and Stainton Way to provide two lanes on the northbound and eastbound approaches to the junction. The aim of this project is to alleviate congestion during the morning and evening peaks. In addition, the scheme will include the resurfacing of both roads and upgrading the existing traffic signals. The proposals are shown on the plan provided by Middlesbrough Council copied on the reverse of this leaflet. The current final date for residents to pass their views to the Council on this scheme is 18<sup>th</sup> March 2018.

As with any proposal of this kind there are positives and negatives and so to ensure residents of Nunthorpe are given the opportunity to debate the issues with the Mayor of Middlesbrough, Mr David Budd, a public meeting has been organised by the Parish Council for **7pm at Chandlers Ridge Academy, Chandlers Ridge, Nunthorpe on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2018**. The meeting will be chaired by the Parish Council Chairman who will put specific, probing questions directly to the Mayor followed by an open debate from the floor.

We would like to see a good turn-out of residents. Subsequent to the meeting, residents will have 12 days to pass any further written comments on to the Council and the Parish Council encourages you to have your say.
